# COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDER MEETING ON ASSEMBLY BILL 1976 | “LAURA’S LAW”

---

In September 2020, the California government passed Assembly Bill 1976 also known as “Laura’s Law.” This piece of legislation builds upon Assembly Bill 1421, which provided the initial pathway for Counties to implement an Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) program if they so desired. Under the new AB 1976, Counties must opt out of providing Assisted Outpatient Treatment or develop a comprehensive AOT implementation plan. Presently, Lake County Behavioral Health Services does not provide AOT services.
